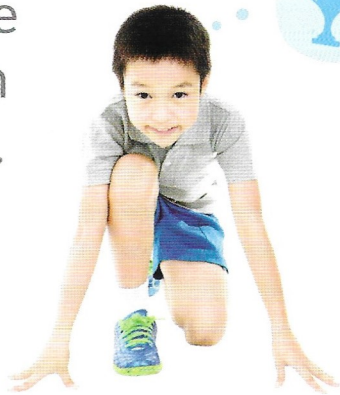


Future tense

the race.

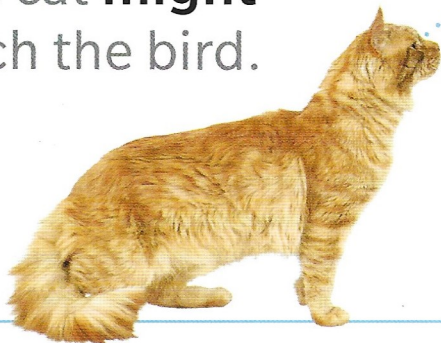


I definitely **won't**
