## Maths– 1,2,3,4,5

This week we will be focusing on the numbers 4 and 5. Support your child to count on and back to these numbers. Challenge them to do 4 or 5 things eg. 4 claps/ 4 jumps/ 4 toe touches etc. reminding them to count and stop at the correct number. Split 4 or 5 items in to 2 groups. Ask them 'If I have 3, how many do you have? 3 and 1 make 4 etc.'

## Colder weather

With the weather due to get colder this week you may like to send your child in with hat/scarf/gloves. Please **make sure that every item has your child's name or initials** on it so we can help them to find their belongings.

If you are providing your child with gloves, then please do not give them mittens. Although these are easy for children to put on independently, this style of glove makes it very difficult for them to pick anything up and take part in child led learning. This may lead to mittens getting discarded somewhere in the garden out of frustration!
