Maths– To 20 and beyond

At home, you can practice counting from 10 to 20 trying to use different starting points. Ask your child to count you out 12, 14, 17 objects.... etc.

The latest Rainbow Challenge is set out here. The challenge is optional but if your child would like to take part, to earn a rainbow pin, then they need to complete the 4 activities.

Evidence can be added to Tapestry in the following way.

Make a new observation for your child on Tapestry with the title Communication and Collaboration. Please add evidence for all 4 challenges to the **same** observation; this can take the form of photos and videos.

You have until **3rd May** to upload your evidence. **All 4 parts of the challenge must be completed to earn the pin. Any evidence added after this date will not be considered.**
