There are a number of children not bringing their water bottles to school. Please ensure that they are at school every day.

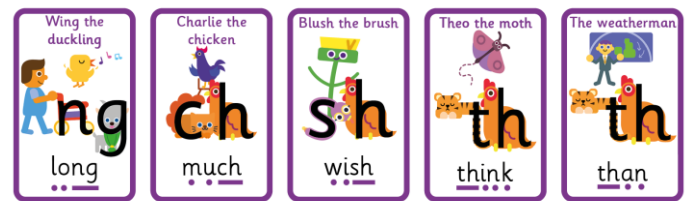
