## Maths– Length, height and time

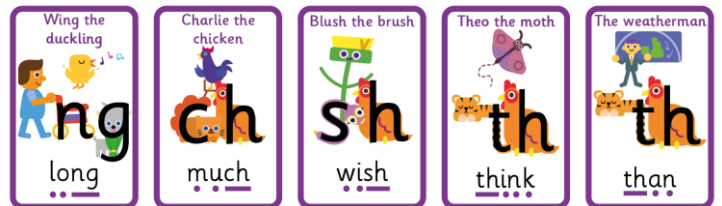
