On this page, you will be prompted to sign up for free as a parent.

Once you navigate yourself to the homepage, you will be met with the below image. Please click on the **Free eBooks for ages 3-11 >** link.



You will then be able to see the below screen. Please select **Levels**, then **Book Band**. A list of different coloured book bands will appear. Please select the colour book band your child is currently reading, set by the class teacher.

Browse the library



Once you have selected your child's reading level, a selection of books will appear. Please click on one of the books to have instant access to the whole book electronically.

Within each book, there should be a page of advice for parents to explain what to discuss with children before, during and after reading the book. It should also highlight featured vocabulary that should be discussed with your child.



We urge that children read the same book for at least two or three days in a row before moving onto the next book. Although your child may be able to read the words in the book easily, it is important that the same text is repeated and appropriate questions are asked to ensure a child's full understanding of the story. Please evidence daily reading in your child's school reading record in the usual manner.
