This year all the classes have a special 'Class Saint'.

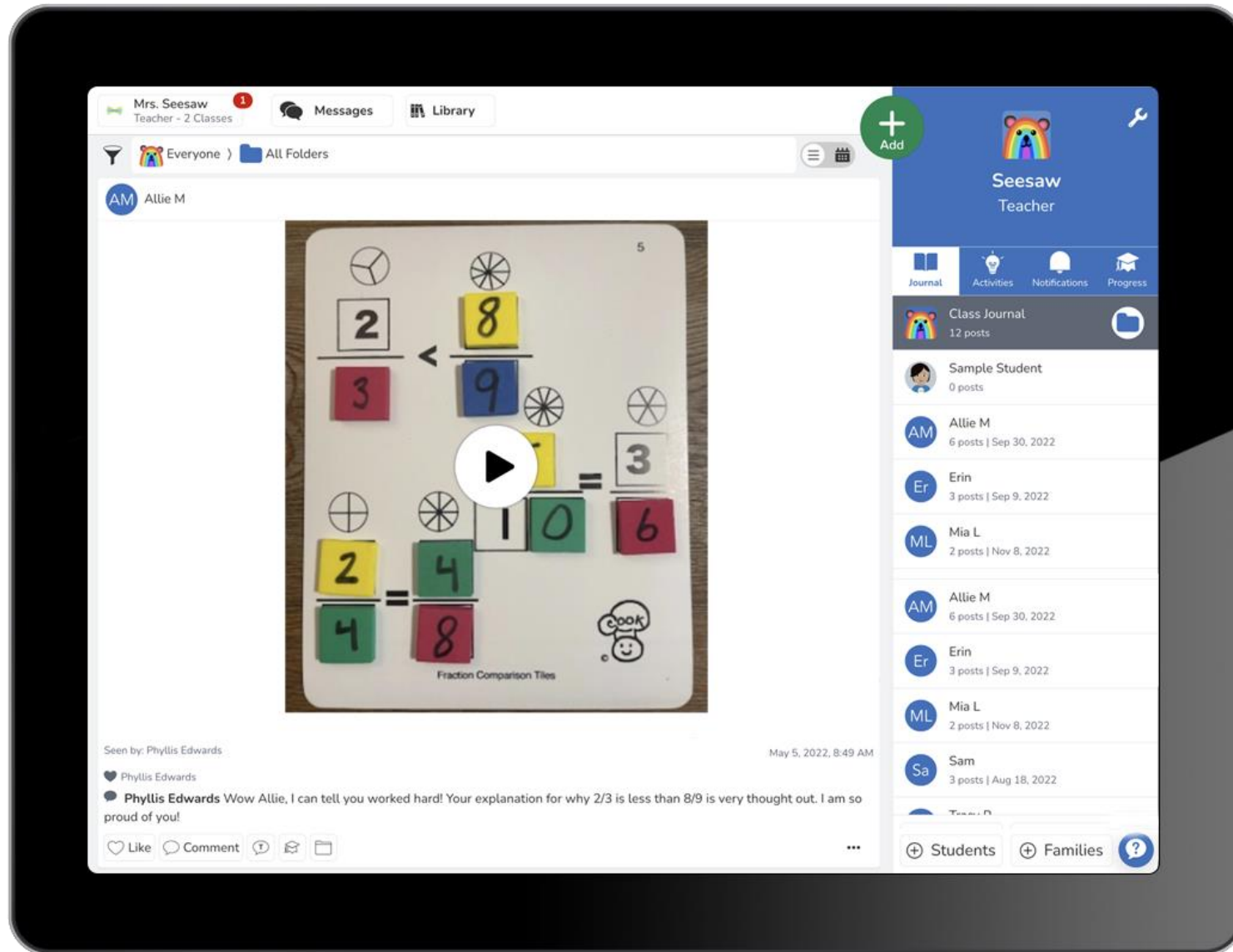
Our saint is
