Passive Screen Time

- Consumptive: watching TV, playing video games, or mindless scrolling.
- Anti-social impact, reducing interaction with others (Resnick, 2018).
- Limits creativity and imagination by replacing real experiences (Hogenboom, n.d.).
- Found to be the most detrimental, linked to poorer prosocial behaviour and lower persistence (Sanders et al., 2019).

Interactive Screen Time

- Involves engagement with the real world through devices (e.g. nature apps, documenting family time).
- Associated with positive educational outcomes when used well (Sanders et al., 2019).
- Can be beneficial if harnessed effectively in learning contexts.

Educational Screen Time

- Well-designed educational content can support behaviour, literacy and cognitive growth (Hogenboom, n.d.).
- Research shows no negative effects, and generally positive links to achievement and persistence (Sanders et al., 2019).

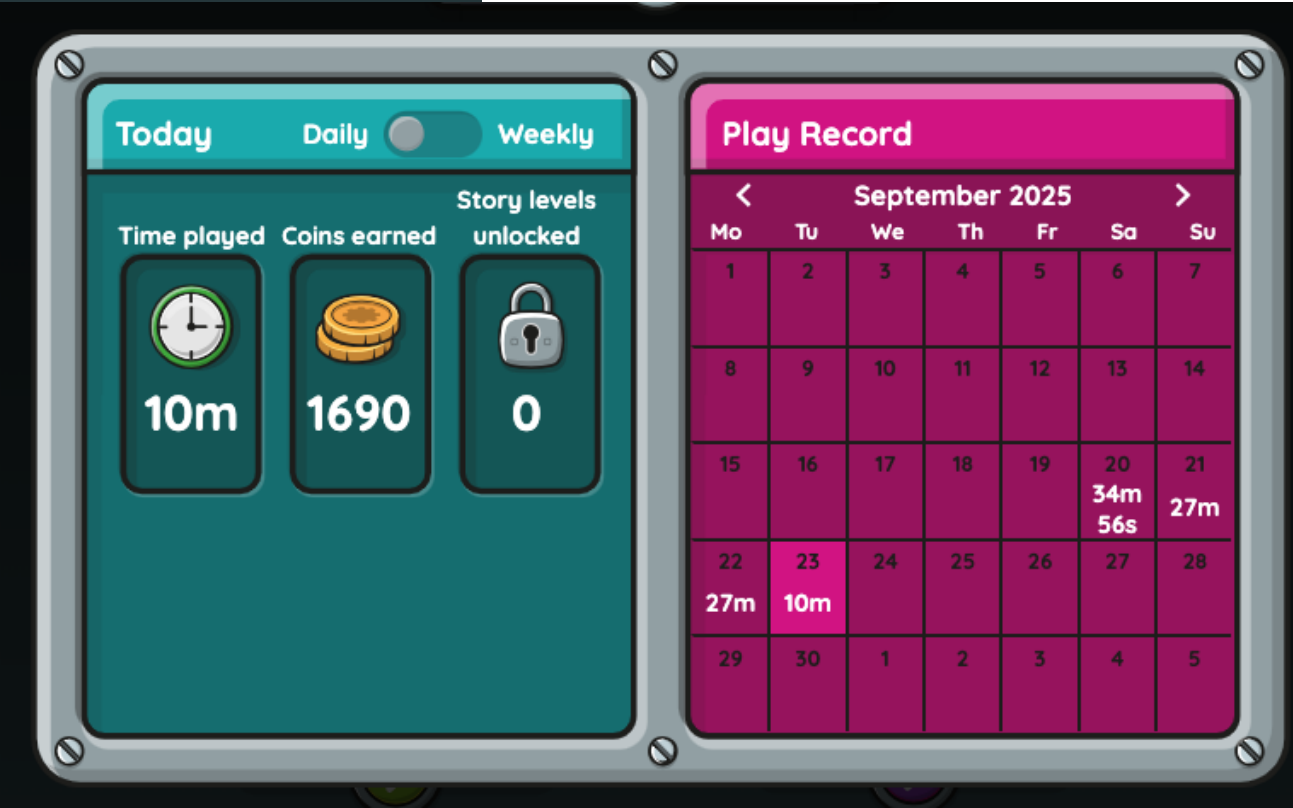

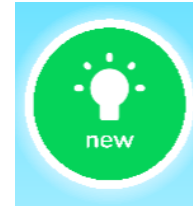

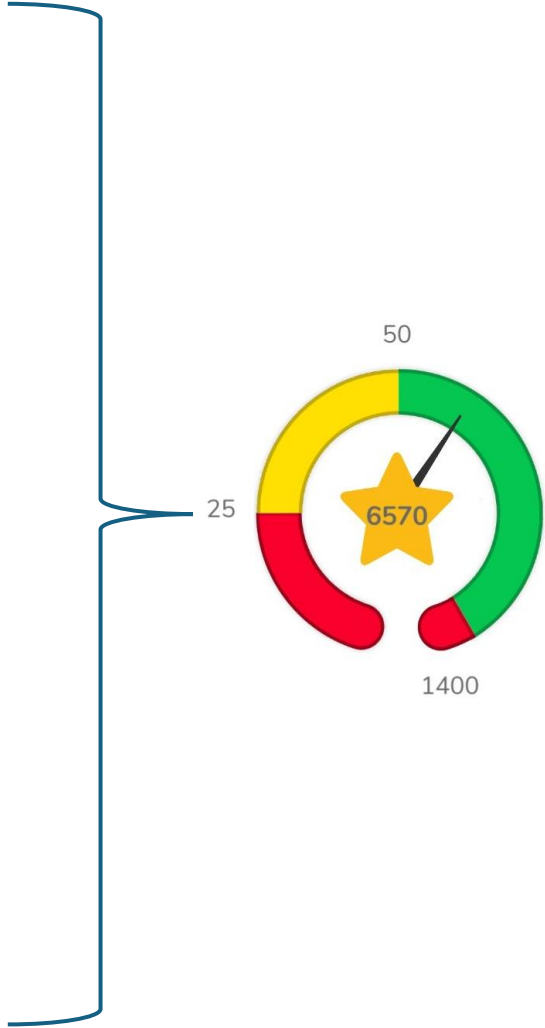
