Poetry

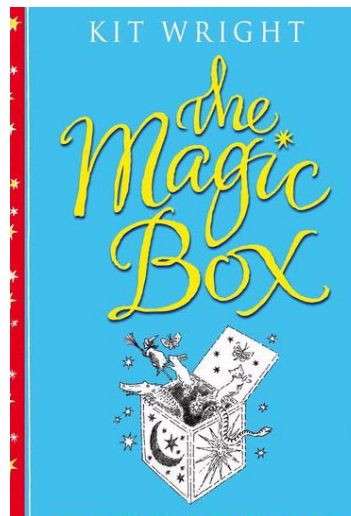
We will study the poem 'The Magic Box' by Kit Wright.

Use Dark Decoder's skills to work out the meaning of new poetic and descriptive vocabulary.

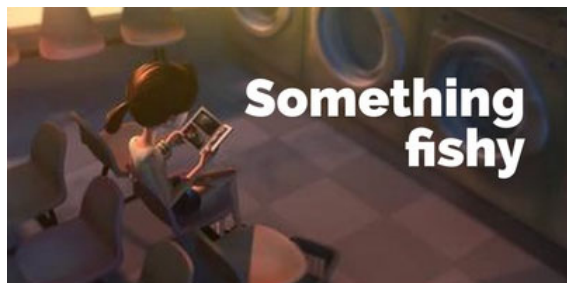
Use Phantom Predictor's skills to guess what the different characters will see in the box.
