Use Phantom Predictor's skills to work out what will happen based on fairy tale conventions.

Rewrite the tale from Little Red Riding Hood's point of view.

Grammar: Non Negotiables and Word Classes

Identify and use nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs in a sentence.

Use capital letters for names of people, places, days of the week, and 'I'.
