

Unit G: Describing People

French

We will learn to:

- Say colours that are useful for describing hair and eyes
- Describe physical features
- Describe a person's personality
- Say what they are wearing
- Use "il" and "elle" with "être" and "avoir"

We will practise these skills:

- Recognise and use singular subject pronouns and the present tense singular forms of some common verbs.
- Grasp the concept that some sentence structures differ in French.
- Give short verbal and written descriptions using full sentences with accurate pronunciation.
- Use the correct articles with plural nouns when prompted.
- Write some simple French sentences to give a summary of a character from a story.
