



Glockenspiel 2

This unit introduces the children to learning about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel. They will also have the opportunity to read simple notated music.

In this unit we will –

1 – Engage in Musical Activities using glockenspiels

- Revise, play and read the notes C, D, E, F and G
- Clap the rhythm of favourite food

3 – Compose Music

Compose using the notes C, D, E, F and G

4 – Perform & Share

- The children will decide how to introduce the performance.
- They will explain to the audience how they learnt the music and why.
- The performances will be recorded and talked about afterwards.

- Improvisations
- Instrumental performances
- Compositions
