Maths— It's Me 1,2,3

This week, we will be learning more about shapes focusing on circles and triangles. Can your children find those shapes around the house or on the way home from school? We will also focus on positional language of over, under, behind, on, through, between. You could use this language with your children while they are tidying up. Put your coat on the hook. Put the box under the table. Put that book between this book and that book....

Phonics

This week, we will be learning the sounds l,h,sh,and. If you haven't already, look at the video on the RWI website to ensure that you are saying the sounds correctly, we use the sounds the letter makes rather than letter names. The link can be found in the learning tab. Activity idea: Show your child a set of objects and get them to group them according to their 'sound' eg. Cup, cap/spoon, salt/ bear boot. Spend some time reviewing previous sounds learnt as well.

PE Shorts

After PE on Friday 2 pairs of shorts were found in the classroom with no name labels in them. If you think these might belong to your child let me know and we will send them home in their bag.

School dinners

At school, we tell the children every day what is on the dinner menu. Although we encourage the children to not have the same meal every day, it is their choice and many of them are comfortable ordering the same food daily.
