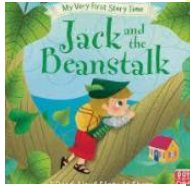


Literacy

Creating a path for a beebot as if it is moving from flower to flower.

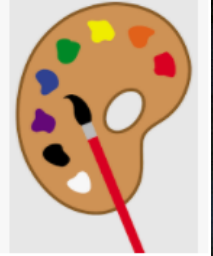
Expressive Arts and Design
