Religious Knowledge:

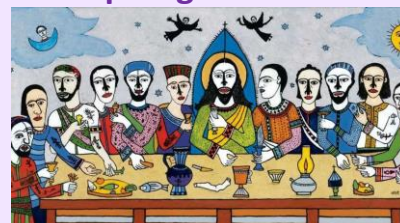
Prior learning: that everyone has good news, and that Pentecost is the celebration of the Good News of Jesus

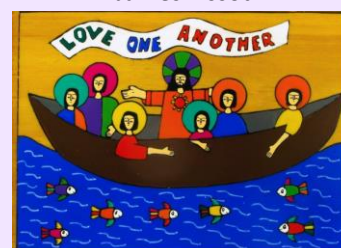
