Maths– Numberblocks-adding and subtracting one

This week we are focusing on what is one more and one less than particular numbers.

You can support at home by doing the following; show me 4 cars, what is one more? Your child may need to add one more and recount them but with more practice they will begin to see the link between the order of numbers and may say what one more is without adding it on and counting. Repeat for different numbers and for one less.

Singing songs like ten monkeys jumping on the bed, ten green bottles can help to make links with one less each time- use visuals eg. soft toys when singing the songs and ask how many each time.

Phonics- Red Words

I will not be updating the red words this week so that we can give the children time to become more confident with the words we have already covered. Please continue to practise the red words over the holidays so the children don't forget them!

Little Red Riding Hood

This week we will be learning the traditional tale- Little Red Riding Hood. By the end of the week your child should be able to retell the story! Please ask them to tell you the story.
