Last week we started a new topic all about 'People who Help us'. Have a look in the information section of the website to see an overview of some of the things that the children will learn as part of the topic.

Last week, the children learned about a few different people who help us such as postal workers, lifeguards, refuse collectors and vets. the children chose to set up a vet's surgery in the role play area and wrote some thank you cards for people who help us. There are photos on the website.

This week the children will be learning about who helps us in an emergency. They will be learning about how to call 999 and what to say. You can help at home by showing them how to call 999 on an available phone (reminding them this is only in an emergency situation where there is no other adult available) and help them to memorise their address.
