The children settled back in to our routines very well last week and had lots of fun with their friends. We finally got a chance to practise using the ipads to take photos so keep an eye out on Tapestry for their 'Tapestry takeover' with the aim of children sharing some of their own learning to initiate conversations at home.

Maths– Building 9 and 10

This week in Maths the children will be comparing and building 9 and 10 by thinking about what numbers make 9 and ten. At home, you could play games with nine or ten items (eg. soft toys/socks/balls) to throw in to a hoop. count how many go in and how many are outside. Say there are 4 in and 6 out, ten altogether- 4 and 6 make 10. Repeat for other numbers.

Phonics- Red Words

The red word video has been updated on google classroom.

Phonics- Set 2 sounds

All the children are learning and practising the Set 2 sounds at school.

This week we will be practicing ay, ee, igh and ow

There are some resources on google classroom that you might find helpful to support your child.

Write Dance paper

The children do 'Write Dance' daily in class. This is where they move their arms in particular ways to music to build up their muscles to help them with their writing. We do one week of movement in the air and one week using crayons on paper, using both hands. So that the children can make nice big movements, we use rolls of paper across the floor. We are running low on our stock of rolls of paper so if anyone has any rolls of wallpaper that they no longer need we would really appreciate them!
