Last week we took part in the RSPB's Big School Birdwatch. Unfortunately, we weren't successful in luring any birds in to our garden- not while we were looking anyway! However, we set up a bird watching station near the field. The children stayed still and very quiet, they used their binoculars to see what was in the distant trees. Luckily we saw lots of birds; pigeons, crows and seagulls (one child was very sure he saw an eagle too)!

Maths– Growing 6,7,8

This week is all about measure. The children will learn how to use non-standard units of measure (eg. cubes) to measure length. They will compare items to towers of cubes saying if they are longer or shorter and learn how to put them in length order. At home you can do the same- gather some items together and put them in order from shortest to tallest by encouraging your child to compare one item with the other. They might like to do this with people in the house too!

Topic- Winter

This week the children are going to become to become weather reporters! They will learn some words to describe the weather and create their own weather reports.

Try to tune in to the Weather this week (bbc iplayer) and explain some of the words that the reporters use.
