Relationship Education: Created to Love Others

Unit 3 of the Live Life to the full programme is about Keeping safe. Through an interactive story where children have to help Freddy Teddy stay safe in various situations, children will explore different ways they can stay safe outside, inside and inside themselves too. They will also be introduced to the idea of bodily privacy (including the NSPCC PANTS message that 'privates are privates') and the importance of talking to their 'special people' if anything troubles them. All this is underpinned by the religious teaching that we are created and loved by God, with bodies and minds that He wants us to keep safe.

Preparation for Year 1

It won't be long now until our Sunflowers leave us and become Butterflies! To help them prepare for the start of the day, from next week you will leave your children on the big playground in the morning where they will line up the same as the rest of the school (they already do this at the end of lunch time).
