## Maths: Find my Pattern

This week we will be focusing on money. The children will learn about finding the totals of items in the 'shop' and begin to learn about change. You can support your child at home by helping them to recognise coins, counting out 1ps and 2ps together and playing shop.

## Sports Day

A few reminders about sports day this Friday.

- Children come to school on Friday already **in their PE kits**- they will not need school bags but must have a **water bottle and a hat with sunscreen already applied**. They should bring their packed lunch if you will not be attending.

## Relationship Education: Created to Love Others

The final session of unit 2 in the Live Life to the full programme is about friendships. Through a story about Freddy Teddy struggling to share at a picnic with his friends, this session helps children consider how to resolve conflict in friendships through saying sorry and asking for/receiving forgiveness. Children will learn that when we hurt others, we also hurt Jesus – but that Jesus teaches us how to forgive ourselves and others.
