Edward Sapir (1884-1939)

An American born linguist who with his pupil, Benjamin Lee Whorf, developed the hypothesis that language influences thought rather than the reverse. The strong form of the Sapir-Whorf hypothesis claims that people from different cultures think differently because of differences in their languages

We will practise these skills:

- understand some simple words and phrases.
- understand simple questions and respond to them, e.g. by picking up an item.
- respond appropriately to songs and rhymes, e.g. by performing a series of actions.
- join in with simple songs and rhymes.
- read familiar words and phrases aloud with accurate pronunciation, so that others can understand
