Monsters

Novel Study

We will read Michael Morpurgo's retelling of the Anglo Saxon legend 'Beowulf'.

During this we will:

Use Dark Decoder's skills and strategies to understand new and unusual words within the story.

Use Word Wolf's skills to explore the writer's intention when using alliteration.

Use Crimson Clue Hunter's skills to explore and make inferences about the feelings and motives of the characters

Write scenes involving one of the characters from Beowulf encountering a new monster, as a continuation of the story.



Comprehension

We will read information texts which involve descriptions of monsters.



During this we will:

Use Captain Comparison's skills to draw comparisons between different monsters.

Use Word Wolf's skills to discuss the authors descriptive vocabulary use.

Use Rocket Retriever's and Dark Decoder's skills to create accurate images of monsters from their descriptions.

Grammar: Nouns and Noun Phrases

We will learn about different types of nouns and how to build noun phrases.

During this we will learn how to:

Identify and use concrete, abstract, collective and proper nouns.

Use articles (a, an) and determiners to introduce and quantify nouns.

Build expanded noun phrases using prepositions to relate positions of nouns to each other.

Use pronouns to replace nouns, show 1st, 2nd and 3rd person, and show possession.

Use commas to separate nouns in a list and to separate adjectives in noun phrases.

Non-Fiction: Instruction

We will read and follow a range of instructions.

During this we will:

Use The Puzzler's skills to discuss layout choices and their effect.

Use Word Wolf's skills to think about the effect of language on how likely a reader is to follow an instruction properly.

Write instructions on how to design and draw a monster.

Write instructions on how to slay a monster.
