Compare and Order Numbers

Ascending order - smallest to greatest.
Descending order - largest to smallest.

Greater Than



Less Than



Equal to



We look at the digit in the ones column when comparing the numbers. If they are the same, we compare the digits in the next column.

Counting in Powers of 10

Counting in 10s

The tens increase until 9 tens become one more hundred and 0 tens.

Counting in 100s

The hundreds increase until 9 hundreds become one more thousand and 0 hundreds.

Counting in 1,000s

The thousands increase until 9 thousands become one more ten thousand and 0 thousands.

Counting in 10,000s

The ten thousands increase until 9 ten thousands become one more hundred thousand and 0 ten thousands.

Rounding

Rule: Underline the digit and look in the next column. If it is 5 or above, add one more. If it is 5 or below, the digit stays the same. Everything after the digit is a zero.

524 → 520

435 → 400
