Dear Parents,

We hope that you had an enjoyable half term. This week we start our topic 'Into the Woods'. Please look at the topic sheet on the website which may help your child to recall what they did at school! Last term, we successfully introduced a 'rainbow challenge' to the children. After completing a particular activity, the children are awarded a coloured stick with the goal of completing a rainbow of coloured sticks by the end of the week which will be exchanged for a rainbow sticker. Talk to your child about what colour they got today!

## Reading books

This week, your child will bring home a folder with their reading book, library book and reading record. They will change these books once a week as indicated in the reading record. The book from the reading scheme will not have any words to start with, this is so you can talk about the characters and story from the pictures while you and your child get used to the routine of reading together at home. Information about how to complete the reading record is stuck in the front.

## Maths- It's Me 1,2,3

In maths, we are learning about the numbers 1,2 and 3. To support at home, ask your child to quickly count out 1,2 and 3 objects from a larger group. Write out the numbers 1,2 and 3 and match objects to each number.

## Phonics

This week, we will be learning the sounds o, c, k, u. You can help your child to practise these sounds by looking for things around the house or outside beginning with the sound. Spend time reviewing previous sounds learnt as well.

## PE kits

PE will take place again this Friday. Please ensure that PE kits are in school by then. It would be helpful if the children's indoor kits only (t-shirt, shorts and plimsolls) are in their bag to avoid any confusion when they are getting changed. Make sure each and every item of clothing is labelled. At home, please continue practising getting dressed independently.
