Maths– Building 9 and 10

This week in Maths the children will be learning more about 9 and 10. They will be looking at how to make 9 and 10 in different ways as well as learning about the order of numbers up to ten.

Phonics- Red Words

In school the children are beginning to learn some 'red words'. These are words that often can't be sounded out. We say, 'You can't Fred a red!' The children need to know these words by sight which will help them with their reading. Regular practising is key to learning these and we hope that you will be able to help at home.

I will put a video of the red words that we are learning on Google Classroom. As we learn more words I will add to this (usually weekly).

Phonics- Set 2 sounds

All the children are learning and practising the Set 2 sounds at school.
