Last week, when we explored the story Lost in the Snow, the children predicted what might happen next to Ollie the puppy. Perhaps when you are reading your story this week, stop the book and get your child to use the clues so far to say what might happen so that they are practising the skill.

Maths– Growing 6,7,8

This week the children will be exploring different ways of making the numbers 6,7 and 8.

You can support at home by asking children to give you 6,7 or 8 objects or by doing exercises that number of times eg. jump 6 times, stamp 7 times etc.

Reading

Please do let us know in your child's reading record how they are doing with the new books that they have taken home. As mentioned before, don't worry if they are still not blending the letters together to read the words. The more practise they get the more confident they will become.

Winter Clothing

The children are becoming much more independent now to dress themselves in all their winter clothing. However, there are still many items without names in them. Sunflower class are now playing on the big playground at lunch time. If they lose any of their items of clothing out there without a name in it then it will not get returned to them and may easily get picked up by another child who has the same/similar items. We do our best to make sure that every child goes home with everything that they came to school with but I am sure that you can appreciate with 30 children it is difficult for us to know who owns what! As mentioned, often the child can not recognize his/her own thing. Please ensure that everything has a name on it- gloves, scarf, hat, coat, water bottle...
