Last week the children were super story tellers and learnt to retell the story of 'The Enormous Turnip'. They drew pictures of their favourite part of the story and made a story map to help them remember the details.

Maths— Alive in 5

This week we are focusing on different ways of making 4 and 5. You can support at home by counting out 4 or 5 objects and arranging them in different ways but showing that the total is still the same. eg. count out 5 pieces of pasta, group them in to 1 and 1 and 1 and 2, look there are still 5. now group them in to 2 and 3- look still 5.etc. How many different ways are there of making 4 and 5?

Topic- Winter

This week we will be exploring Winter stories. The children will be thinking about what clothes they need for Winter to keep them warm and using the correct names. They will also be thinking about what footprints animals make in the snow.

We would love to see on tapestry any Winter activities that your child takes part in.

Winter Clothing

With cold weather expected this week, please ensure that any gloves/ scarves/ hats that you send to school contain your child's name. This helps the children to be more independent in finding their own things and the staff can help them if needed. Please help your child at home to practise putting on all of their winter things (especially gloves!) so that they can independently do this.
