Dear Parents,

The children are settling in beautifully to new routines and are building friendships with other children in Sunflowers class. Often, conflicts can occur with other children but we are teaching the children strategies to solve problems with others. Initially, this may involve telling an adult who then gives them advice about what to say to a child who might have hurt their feelings or taken their toy. We hope to equip the children with the skills to resolve conflicts themselves. You can talk to your child about what they might say or do if they have a problem with another child. If something is really worrying them, encourage them to speak to an adult independently, but of course if they don't feel able to do this then contact Mrs Munday, via the office.

Tapestry

This week we will be finishing our baseline assessments to establish the starting points for all children. It would be extremely helpful if you could add pictures and videos to Tapestry showing us what your children can do at home; things that we may not have seen at school yet. This helps us to get a full picture of your child. Send as much as possible, that you feel is relevant this week, then after that once a week will be plenty.

PE kits

Next Friday we intend on starting our first PE sessions. If you haven't sent it in already, please ensure your child has an indoor PE kit in school- a white t-shirt, school shorts and plimsolls. Please make sure that everything is labelled. This will be taken home with the children at the end of the day on Friday to be washed and returned the following week.
