Other activities to do:

- Go on a 2d shape hunt around your house. Talk about the different shapes you see.
- Play a guessing game. Talk about the objects in the house and describe them. Can your child guess what it is?
- Cook with your child and focus on following instructions, and observing changes.
- Stay active by doing a 5 minute Body Coach exercise session (YouTube – The Body Coach 5 minute kids workout).
- Use recyclable materials to make models or props to use in imaginative role play (eg, a treasure chest to help when pretending to be a pirate!).
- Play board games with your child. Focus on following rules and reacting well if they lose.
