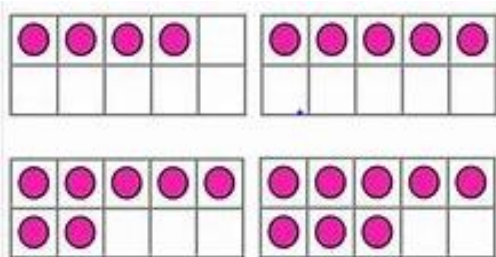

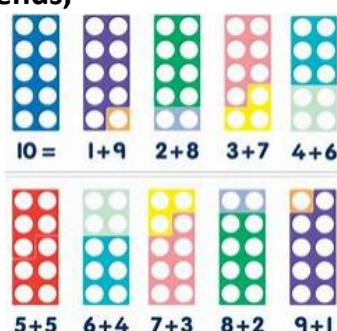
Maths
