Dear parents and carers

Children are doing really well with their phonics, and are using their sounds to confidently read words. To support with their writing, we would kindly ask you to continue testing your child on all of their sounds, but instead of showing them a sound and getting them to say it, it would support their development if you could say a sound and get them to write it down.



Maths

This week in maths we exploring comparing numbers to 10. You can support your child at home with this by doing activities such as:

Provide children with a collection of items to sort. Encourage children to sort the item into sets and then compare the quantity in each set. Ask questions such as 'Can you find a set with more than this one? Can you find 2 sets with the same quantity? How many more does set A have than set B?'

This week within our topic of Long Ago and Far Away, we will be exploring the texts of Rapunzel and Rumpelstiltskin.
