Dear Parents

School Uniform

Please show your child what the label looks like and where it is so that they can easily recognise their own items. Similarly, book bags and water bottles should also be labelled. Continue practising taking on and off jumpers and cardigans at home so that the children can do this more independently.

Book bags

As you may have seen, we have a new mobile cloakroom installed in our outside area. This does not fit the children's bags on their pegs and for this reason please could we ask that your child brings a book bag only to school.

School dinners

The children have been enjoying choosing what they would like to eat for their school dinners. Please spend some time looking at the menu for the week with your child so they can decide what they would like to eat on each day. Many children will still need to practise using a fork and knife for their dinner, so continued practise of this at home will be a great help.
