

# Unit D: Playtime

## French

### We will learn to:

- understand some simple words and phrases;
- understand and follow some simple instructions;
- understand and recognise a question;
- pick out familiar words and phrases from spoken sentences;
- use knowledge of French phonics to help spell familiar words;
- recite a simple finger rhyme or song from memory;
- express my opinions using simple sentences;
- prepare and present a set of simple instructions to a group for them to follow;
- write a few simple sentences about ourselves;
- talk about ourselves using some common verbs in the first person singular form.

### Important figures:

Edith Piaf (1915 – 1963)



French street singer turned music icon. Regarded as France's national chanteuse (singer), Piaf redefined France's status in the music industry with hit songs like *La Vie en Rose*.

### We will practise these skills:

- Listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding.
- Explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words.
- Engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others.
- Present ideas and information orally to a range of audiences.
- Appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language.

### We will ask and answer these questions:

<i>Qui est dans le pré?</i>	Who is in the meadow?
<i>...est dans le pré.</i>	...is in the meadow.
<i>Qu'est-ce que Jacques a dit?</i>	What did Jacques say?
<i>Qu'est-ce que tu aimes faire dans la cour?</i>	What do you like to do in the playground?
<i>J'aime...</i>	I like...
<i>À quoi tu aimes jouer?</i>	What do you like to play?
<i>Où tu aimes jouer?</i>	Where do you like to play?
<i>J'aime jouer...</i>	I like to play...

<i>Dites 'bonjour'!</i>	Say 'hello'!	<i>dans le pré</i>	in the meadow
<i>Dites 'au revoir'!</i>	Say 'goodbye'!	<i>à l'intérieur</i>	inside
<i>Frappez dans les mains!</i>	Clap your hands!	<i>dehors</i>	outside
