- > Can you make a list of the pros and cons of drones? What other ways could they be used?

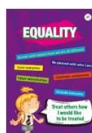

We all have a say.

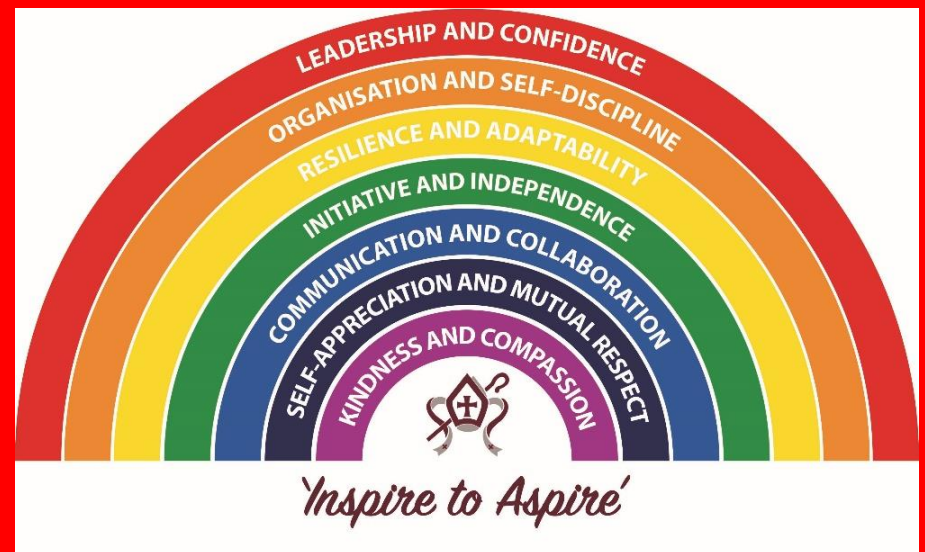

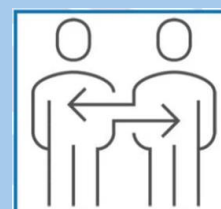
