In the news this week

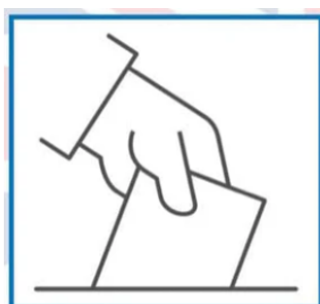

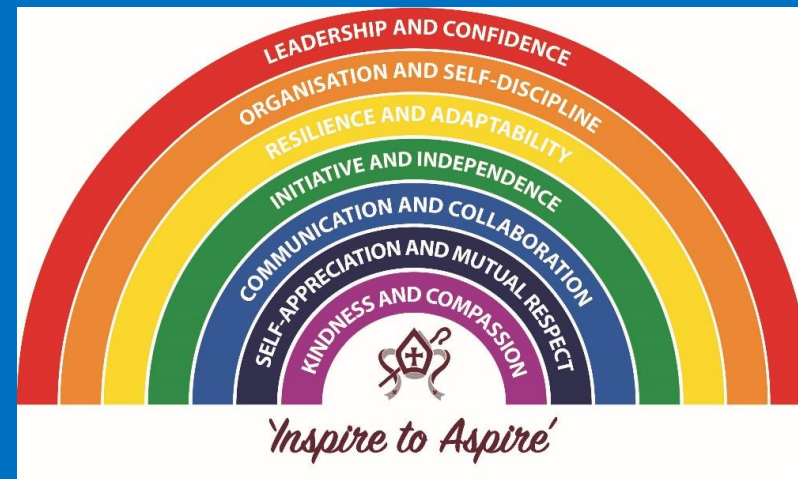
Our opinion and our vote matters.
