We will learn about the different parts of a mosque and how they are used, including the prayer hall and wudu (ritual washing). We will learn about the minaret and how this is used to project the call to prayer.

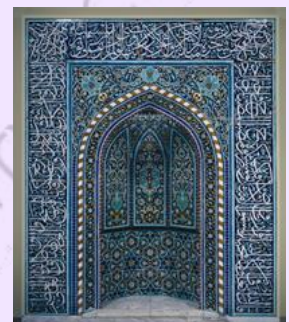
