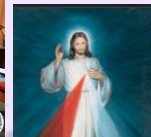

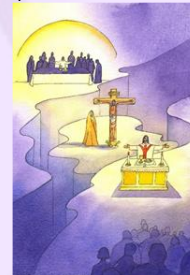

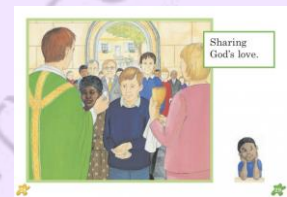
At Mass we pray with Christ who reaches out to the Father in the burning love of the Holy Spirit – Elizabeth Wang
