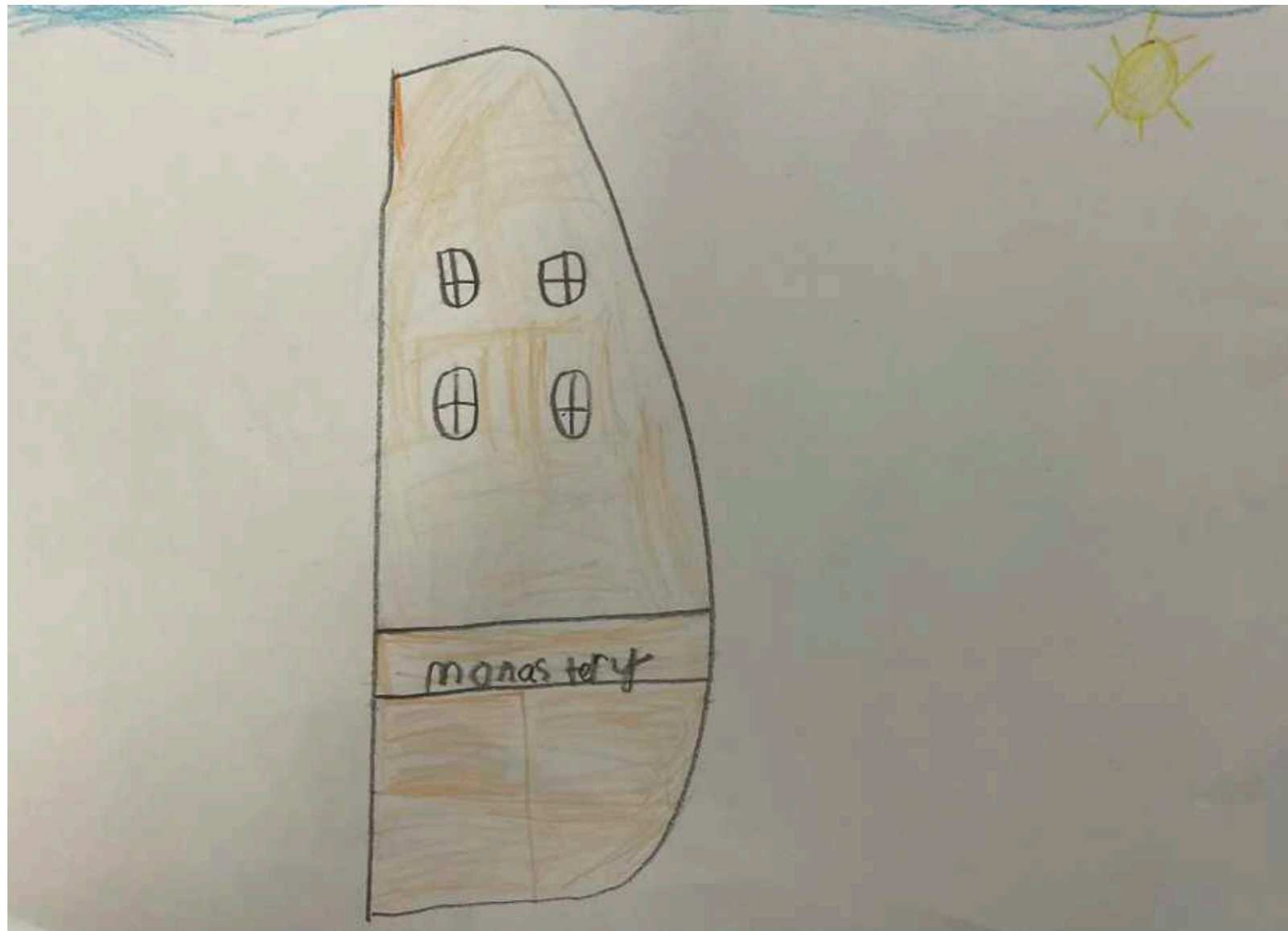

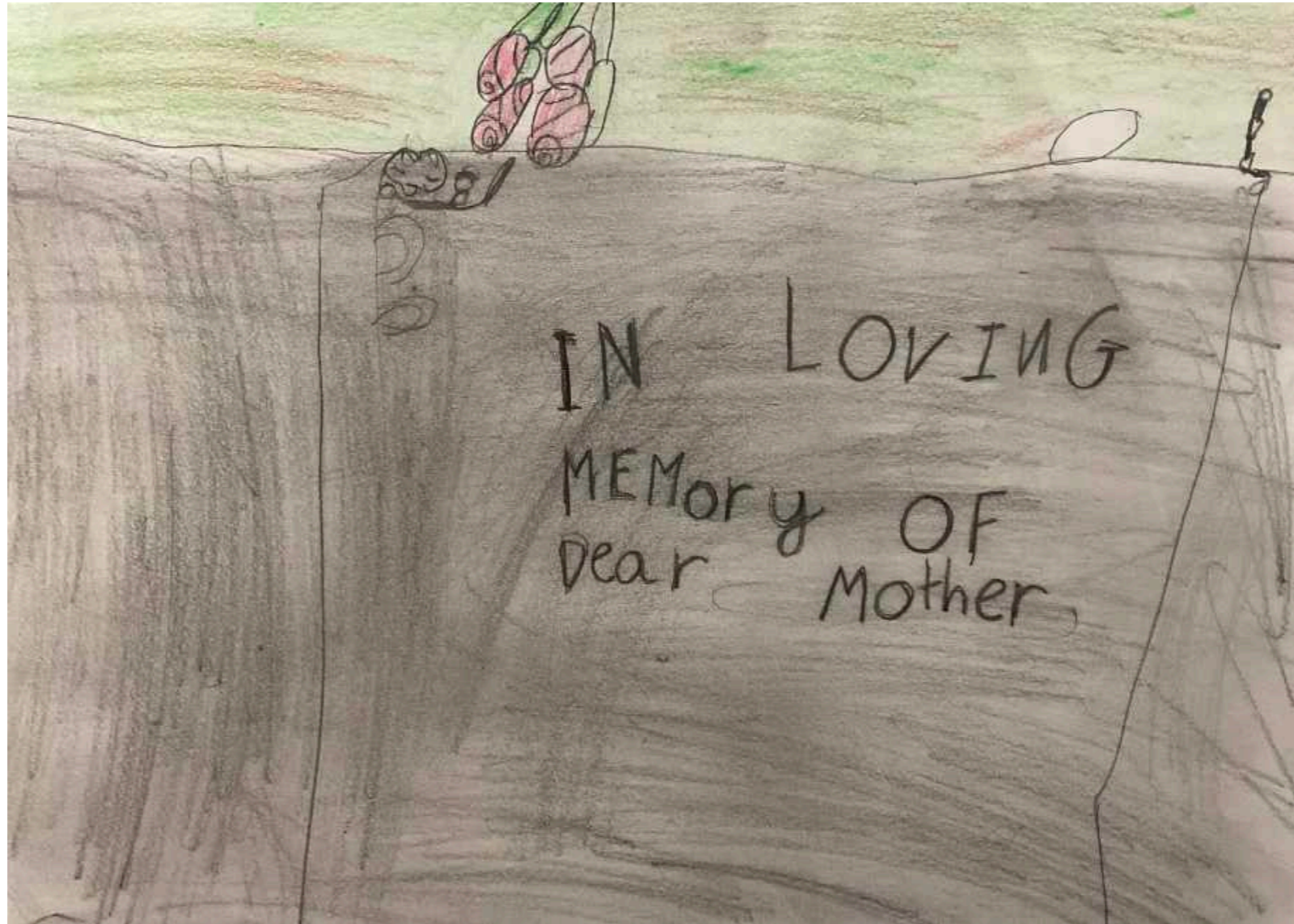
Anselm was born in Aosta in Italy near the mountains.

Anselm went to England and became the Archbishop of Canterbury.

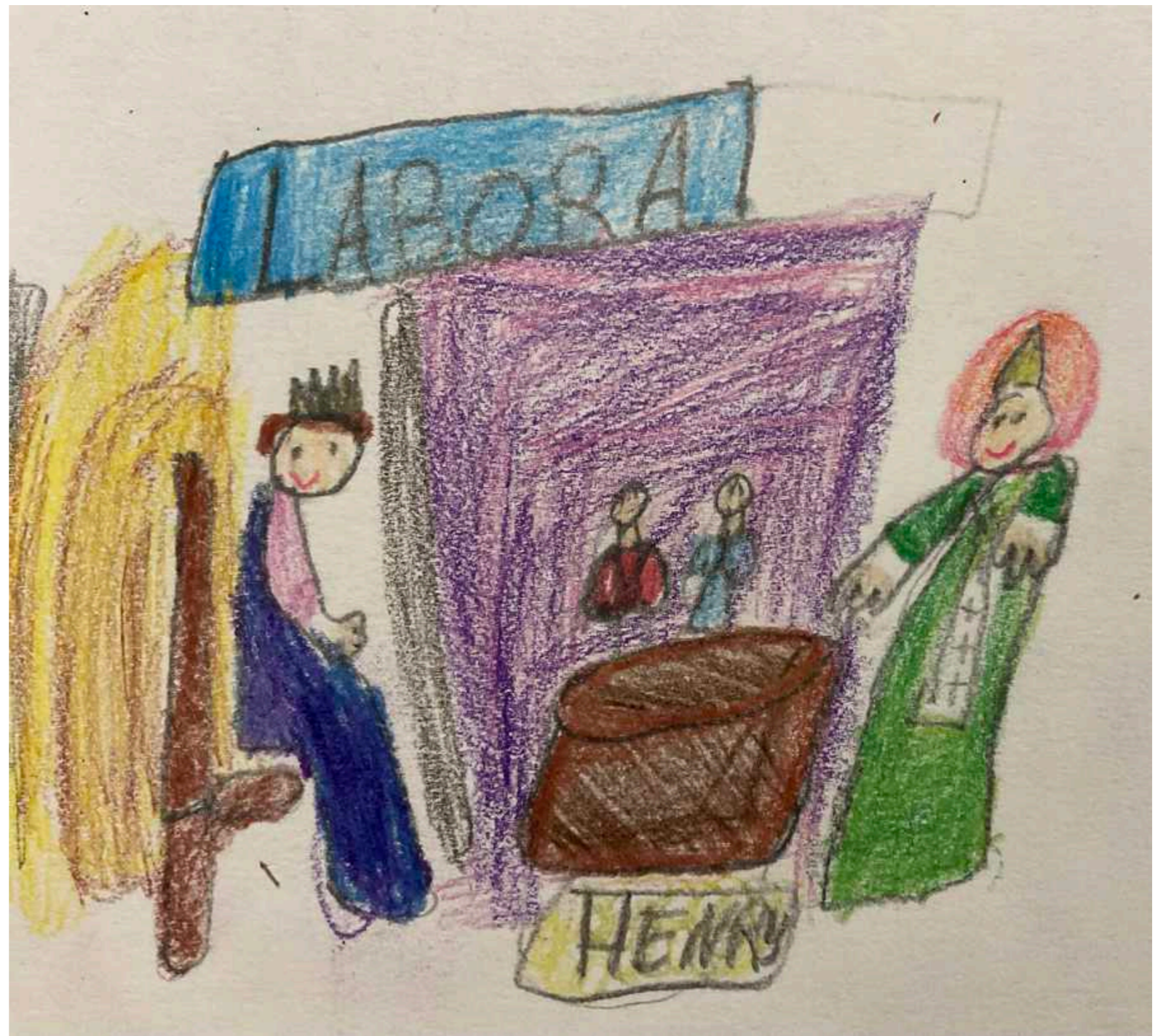


Anselm started arguing with the kings because he wanted to listen to the pope and do what he said.

peacefully.

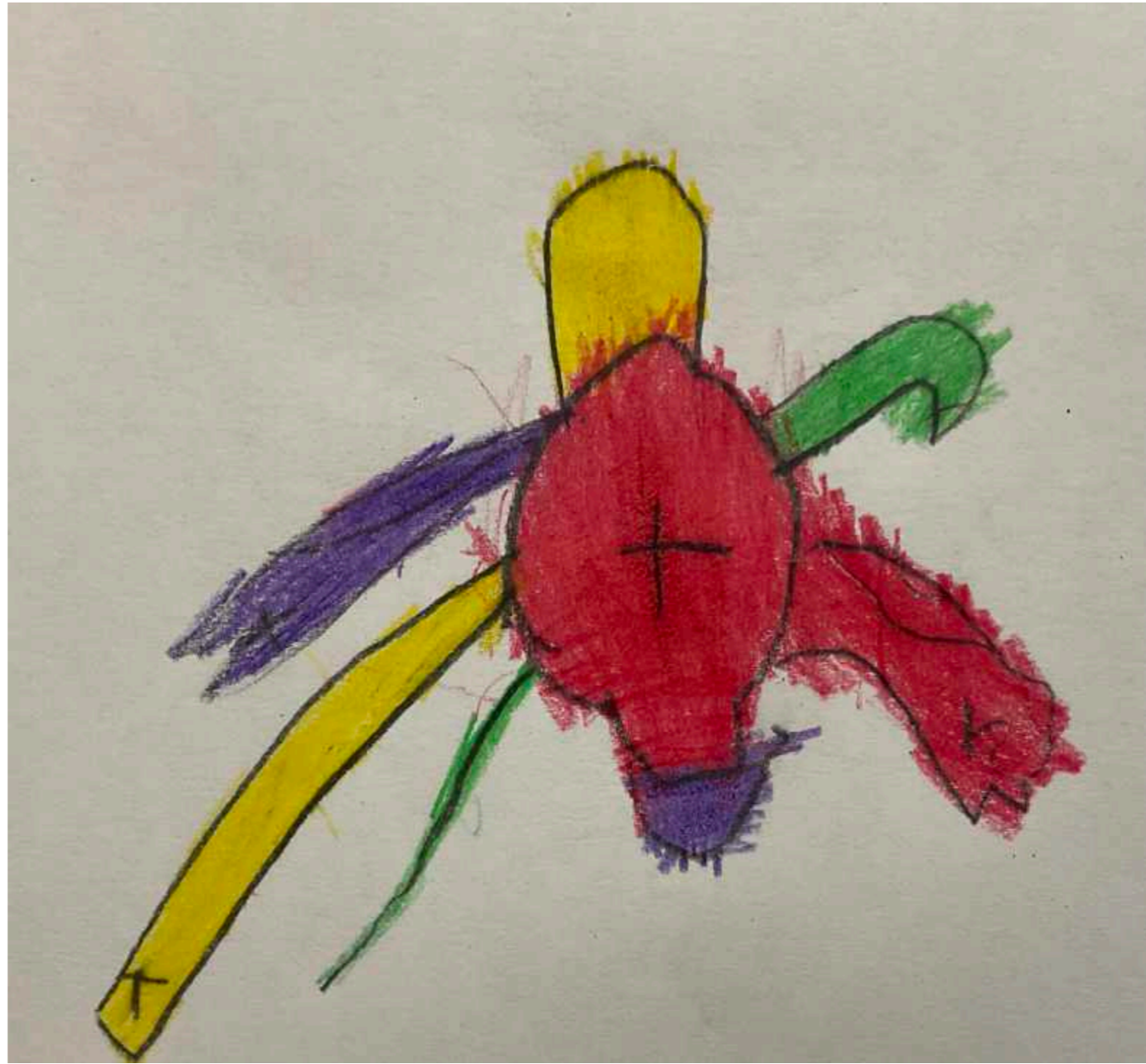




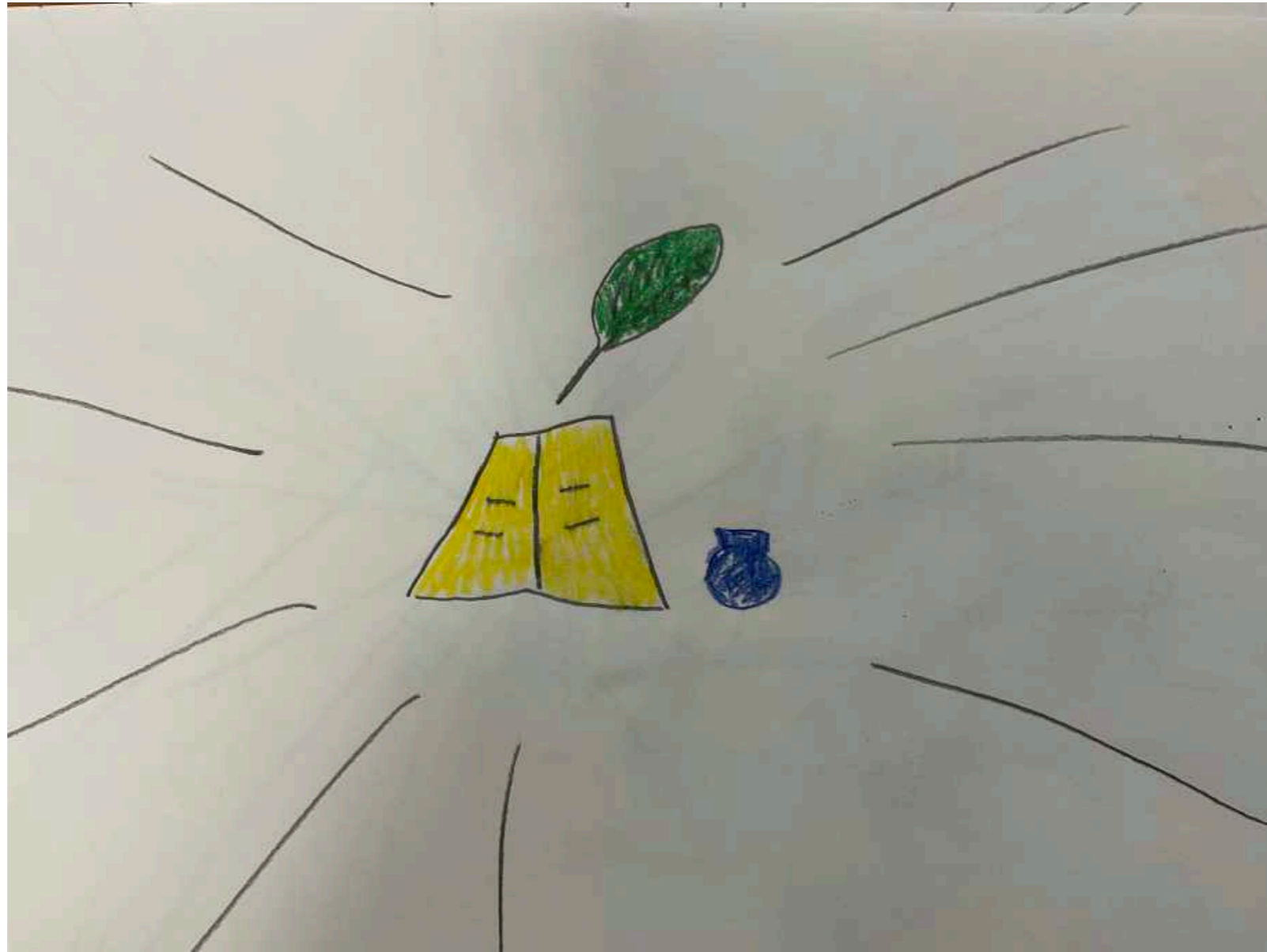
Anselm wrote about God many times in thick books.
