## Knowing More, Remembering More

Knowing more in Y2

- ❖ Why do people go on holiday to the seaside, and what were seaside holidays like when our grandparents were young? People go to the seaside for fun, to relax, and enjoy the beach. When our grandparents were young, seaside holidays had things like donkey rides, old-fashioned bathing suits, and lots of traditional games.
- ❖ How can we learn about seaside holidays in the past, and how are they different from today? We can look at old photos taken with Box Brownie cameras (from 1900) or picture postcards (first made in 1894). Today, people use mobile phones and social media to share pictures instead. In the 1970s, camcorders let people film their holidays. Seaside holidays are different now, with things like theme parks, but in the past, they had donkey rides!
- ❖ How can souvenirs help us learn about seaside holidays in the past? Souvenirs, like seashells, postcards, or little toys, can tell us what people enjoyed about their seaside holidays. By looking at these, and using other sources like photos, we
