Writing Outcomes:

1. To write a Fairy Tale - The adventure of another robot that helps others.
2. To create a set of instructions for surviving on a deserted island.

Grammar:

1. Identify main clauses and co-ordinating conjunctions.
2. Use co-ordinating conjunctions (for, and, but, or, yet, so).
3. Choose nouns and pronouns to avoid repetition.
4. Identify subordinate clauses and conjunctions.
5. Use subordinating conjunctions (if, as, when, although, while, after, before, because).
6. Know that commands contain imperative verbs.

Composition:

1. Discuss writing similar to that which they are planning to write in order to understand and learn from its structure, vocabulary, and grammar
2. In narratives, create settings, characters and plot
3. Assess the effectiveness of their own and others' writing and suggest improvements
4. Assess the effectiveness of their own and others' writing and suggest improvements

Speaking and Listening:

1. Use intonation to emphasise grammar and punctuation when reading aloud.
2. Bring stories to life with expression and intonation.
3. Engage in discussions, making relevant points.
4. Use vocabulary that is appropriate to the topic being discussed or the audience that is listening.

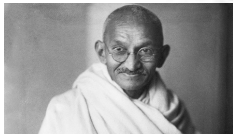
