Reading

Please ensure that your child returns their reading folder on their designated day this week. Kent libraries are also running a Summer reading challenge which your child can sign up for at your local library. Please keep reading with your child over the summer- they have worked so hard to learn how to read and need to keep practising.

Story

This week the children will have an opportunity to create and write their own story. Encourage your child to tell simple stories at home, if your child finds it difficult then use a story that they know well and change a few details or use some props/toys to help.

Maths: On the Move

This week we will be focusing on creating and following maps and mazes to increase the children's spatial awareness. Why not get your child to draw a map of an obstacle course and then make it- full sized for themselves or a mini one for a toy!

Relationship Education: Created to Live in Community

Module 3 of the Live Life to the full programme introduces in a very simple way the concept of the Trinity, where God is three-in-one and each part loves the others and loves us. Children will come to understand that as we are made in the image of God, we are designed to love God and love one another in our wider communities too. Through the story of Jesus feeding the 5000 with just the humble offering of a small boy, children will learn that our loving actions can be used by God to do incredible things.
