Last week the children loved learning about Dina Asher Smith. Take a look at the photos on the website of some of their super writing.

As part of our RE learning about 'The Church', we will be paying a visit to the church this week. Please send your child to school with a raincoat just in case! The children will be learning about Baptism we would appreciate if you could upload a photo from their baptism on to Tapestry which we can use as a talking point.

## Story

This week the children will be learning the story of the enormous turnip. They will learn to retell a simple version of the story, make a story map and write the story.

Encourage your child to practise retelling the story at home. I will make a simple powerpoint available on Google Classroom with pictures which might help them to remember the main parts of the story.

## Maths: On the Move

This week we will be focusing on complicated patterns. The children will be making ABBC type patterns and circular patterns, saying what will come next in the pattern. During their play at home ask your child to use their toys to make a repeating pattern eg. teddy, lego block, lego block, book then repeat. Can they notice any repeated patterns around the house- eg. tiles, paintings etc.

This week will be the last week receiving book band books- we will collect all of these in next week on your child's normal book change day.
