Story

This week we will be finding out about minibeasts including snails, caterpillars and ladybirds. We will be using science kits to find and look at bugs closely before returning them safely to where we found them. What bugs can you find in the garden or near your home? Look closely and talk about the features of the different bugs that you find. Please add any interesting bug finds to Tapestry!

Maths: To 20 and beyond

This week as well as continuing counting we will be looking at the properties of 2D shapes and making patterns using shapes. At home you could make repeating patterns together using household objects (fork, spoon, fork, spoon..) colours, lego or blocks. If you make a pattern see if your child can copy or continue it. Try to make a pattern with a repetition every 3 objects (fork, spoon, knife, fork, spoon, knife).

This week in the final session of unit 2 of the 'Live Life to the Full' programme called 'Me, My body and Health', the children will begin to learn about how they need to look after their bodies and how to be healthy. They will learn a little about diet, exercise, sleep and personal hygiene.
