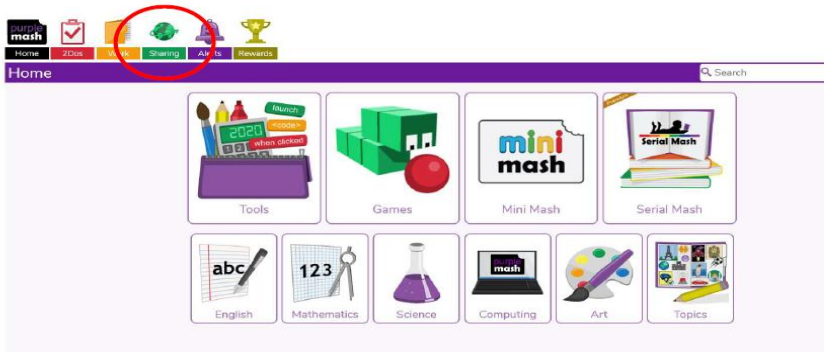


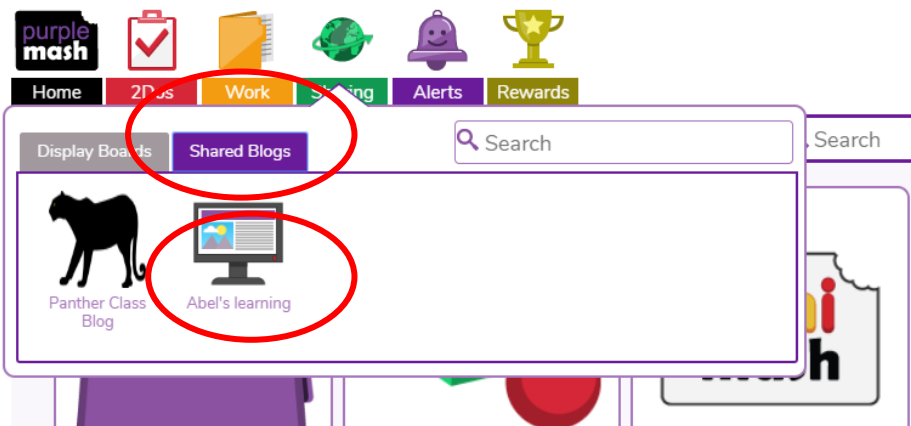
Using the Purple Mash blog to submit work for feedback

- Upload your home learning work here for feedback. You can copy and paste it from a word document, take a photo and upload it or scan your work and upload it.

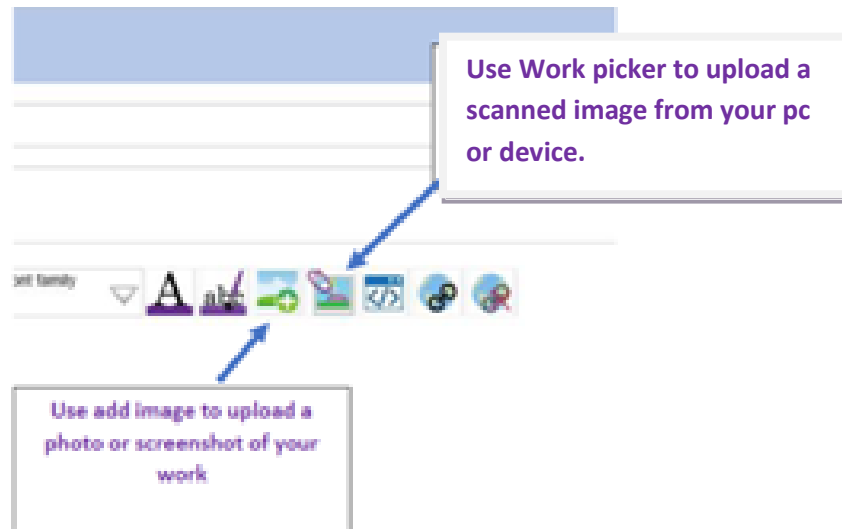
5. Click the '+' button
