Behaviour

All children are expected to follow the Pride Values. Each class has a behaviour chart.

SUN - All children start the day on the Sun.

CLOUD – A warning that they are not behaving appropriately.

RAINDROP – Children are continuing to misbehave ... Time out - Lose some of playtime; sent to another class.

LIGHTNING – Still continue to misbehave, disruptive, fighting, physically hurting others, swearing, vandalism and other serious behaviour – Sent to Head or Deputy, parents informed.

Things to remember to bring in

Water bottle (Sports Top)

PE kit (including tracksuit top and bottom; socks if girls are wearing tights) on Thursday

Trainers if required (Monday – Thursday)

Classroom Routines

Toilets :

The children are encouraged to go to the toilet and wash their hands at several allocated times during the day due to Covid. (Please make us aware if your child has a medical need to go more often)

Jumpers/ Cardigans:

The children are encouraged to put them in their bags to avoid them getting lost. Please ensure that they are **labelled**.

Water Bottles:

Children need a **sports top** water bottle (to avoid spills) in school every day. This keeps the child hydrated, more alert and ready to learn.

These will come home to be cleaned and refilled each night.

Home time:

The children are encouraged to collect all their belongings before going out to the playground. They will not be allowed to go back into the building due to cleaning routines.

Children can only be collected by people that the parents have named on the collection form or if they have phoned to let us know. Please could you inform the office who will be collecting your children each afternoon to avoid any confusion. We are not allowed to release the children to anybody who hasn't been identified to us on the collection form.
