Meet the Flintstones

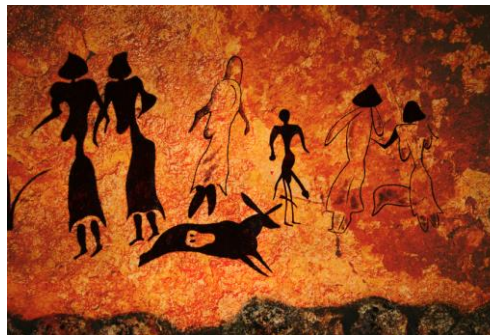
