Year 3/4 Easter – Fruits of the Spirit

After Pentecost, when the disciples had received the Holy Spirit, they went around teaching people about God. The Holy Spirit had given them the strength to share the good news. Over 2000 years later, the Holy Spirit is working in us too.

The fruits of the Holy Spirit are described in Galatians 5:22-23.



The word 'fruit' is used to describe the results of the Holy Spirit, what we show when the Holy Spirit is working within us. We can use pictures of fruit to help us remember these. Take a look at these scripture quotes where each 'fruit' is described.

Love And you must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength. Deuteronomy 6:5 (NLT)	Gentleness Pursue a godly life, along with faith, love, perseverance, and gentleness. 1 Timothy 6:11b (NLT)
Peace May the Lord show favor toward you, and give you peace. Numbers 6:26 (NLT)	Patience Meanwhile, the saints stand passionately patient, keeping God's commands, staying faithful to Jesus. Revelation 14:12 (The Message)
Faithfulness Great is Your faithfulness. Lamentations 3:23b (NASB)	Self-Control A person without self-control is like a house with its doors and windows knocked out. Proverbs 25:28 (The Message)
Joy My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song. Psalm 28:7 (NIV)	Kindness But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Galatians 5:22-23a (NIV)
Goodness Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever. Psalm 23:6 (KJV)
